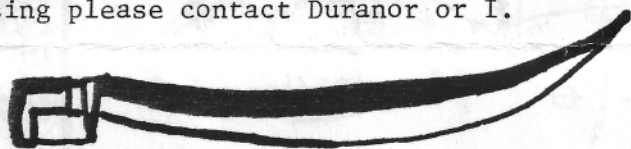

Please see attached list of names and addresses of all in our shire. If your address is wrong, or if any information(society name, address,phone#) is missing please contact Duranor or I.

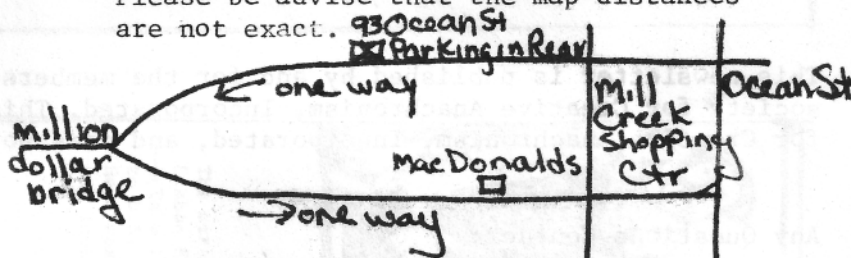


FIRST TOURNEY EVENT & KINGS' BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

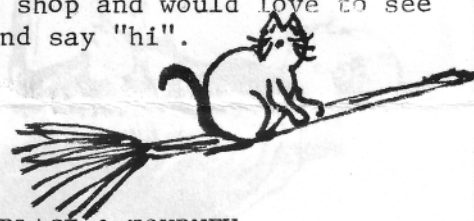
If you haven't already received the leaflet on the days events please read the attached on all the wonderful things happening that day.

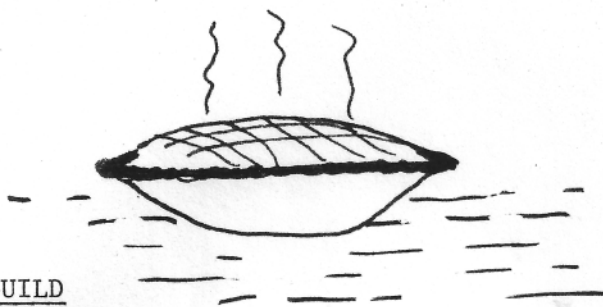

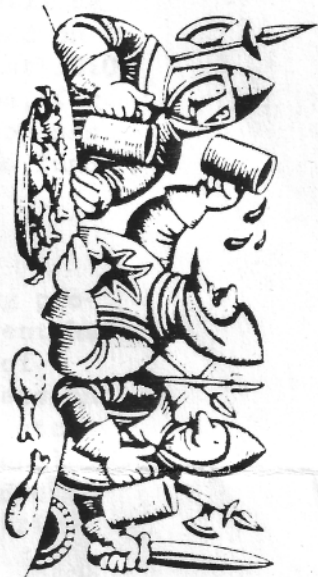

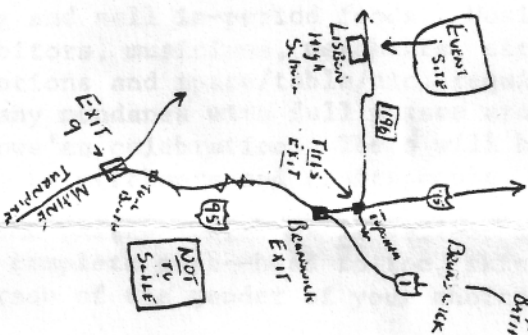

Carolingia

In Salem, Massachusetts, on Saturday, October 31, 1981, there will be a PRIZE TOURNEY and MEDIEVAL MARKETPLACE. The event will be held on the Salem Common. Set-up starts at 9:00 am. The event starts at 10:00 am and ends at 5 pm. Donations are one tyger (\$1.00) per person, for fighters and non-fighters alike. Any monies remaining after expenses are met will be added to the Send-Their-Majesties-to-Drachenwald fund.

PRIZES

About five hundred dollars' worth of merchandise prizes is being provided by the Salem Chamber of Commerce. The Autocrat of the event has been given the right to approve the prizes. They will consist of six- to eight-yard lengths of velvets and brocades, pewter goblets and plates, boxes of useful size handpainted with period-style art, etc. Don't worry--there won't be any sunglass cases or discount at local beauty shop sorts of things. Some of these prizes will be awarded to fighters, some to craftsmen, and some for garb. There is no restriction on the number of prizes one individual may win.

The Tourney

The form of tourney will be determined by the number of fighters present at 10:00 am; whatever arrangement is most fair and can still be completed by 4:30 pm. There will be prizes for the winner of the tourney, the outstanding novice, and the fighter with the most authentic-looking armor.

The Marketplace

Artisans, merchants, and guilds are welcome to exhibit and/or sell-- No extra fees and NO RAKEOFF. Hawkers welcome. Cooks encouraged to bring and sell in-period foods. Musicians may pass the hat. All exhibitors, musicians, merchants, etc. must NOTIFY the autocrat of their intentions and space/table/etc. requirements by October 17. There will be many mundanes with full purses around, as all this is part of Salem's Hallowe'en celebration. There will be prizes for the best-looking displays by merchants and craftspeople.

COSTUME PRIZES--Well, it is Hallowe'en. There will be prizes for the most complete garb--head to toe, skin out. Layers to be examined by a person of the gender of your choice.

--We will have a hotel room right across the street from the Common, for changing and security. --Tables and chairs will be provided for merchants and craftspeople, if you notify the autocrat of your needs by Oct. 17. --There is a rain site two blocks from the Common: a wooden-floored armory.

There will be a bus (free) leaving Boston at 8:30 am. Contact the autocrat for details and meeting point and reservations. Otherwise, find a roadmap. Go to Salem MA. Follow signs to the center of town. That's where the Common is. In case of rain, there will be signs at the Common directing you to the armory.
