



First of all, I would like to congratulate the Malagentian Archery Troop for their fine performance at the Pennsic War Point Shoot. Although the East lost the War Point, Malagentia accounted for 11 of the East's 128 points. Our eleven archers scored at least one point each with the exception of Arlof who missed by only inches. Arlof and Brendan had never shot before, much less practiced, and still did well.

Sheppa and myself each scored two points, while Brendan, Ariel, Deormund, Jaroslav, Larissa, and Malachi each scored once. You may notice that only adds up to ten (the Barbarians won't notice, of course). Larissa may have scored two points, but her own bad eyesight and an over-anxious marshall who pulled all the arrows from the first target, put that in question. I will definitely give her the benefit of the doubt and claim 11 points for the Shire.

The novelty shoots this year were very enjoyable. Although, we didn't win anything, a good time was had by all. Our friend and ally, Donal McAyre won the traditional Longbow shoot. There was a slit shoot simulating a castle defense, where Malachi and Sheppa did well. Also there were both a Woods Shoot and a Knight Shoot, in which you shot targets at 20 Yds., your fearless archery captain was doing extremely well in the Knight Shoot with 50 of a possible 60 points - the hurricane hit! 
